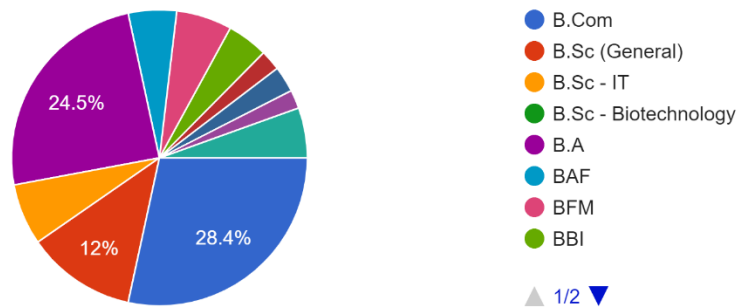

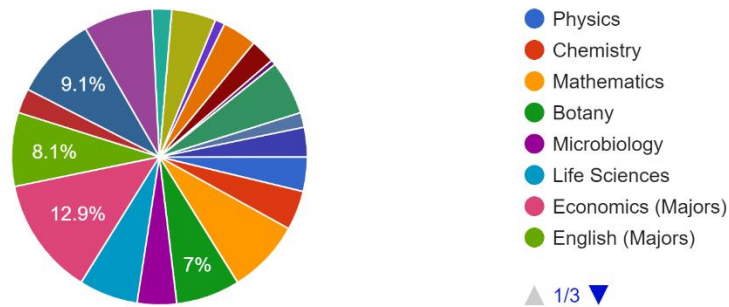

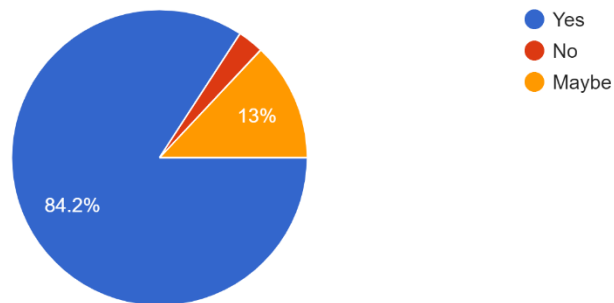
If graduation completed in B.Sc (General) or BA, what was your subject at TY level?

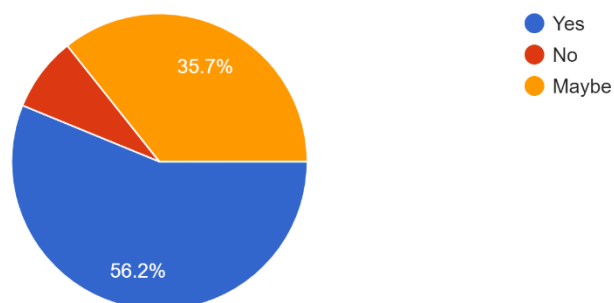

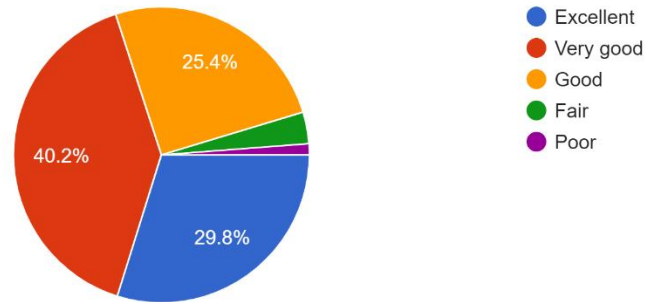

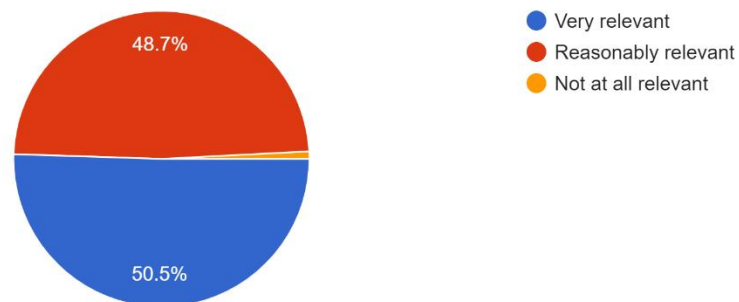

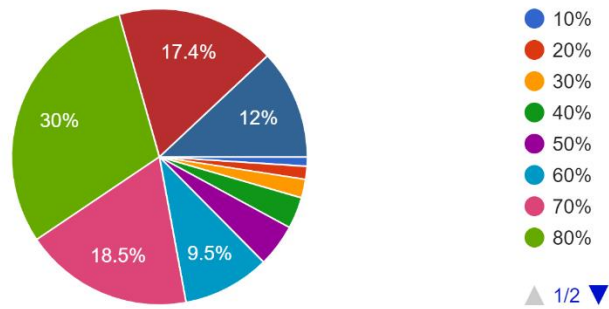


Was the Syllabus relevant as per the overall structure of the program?

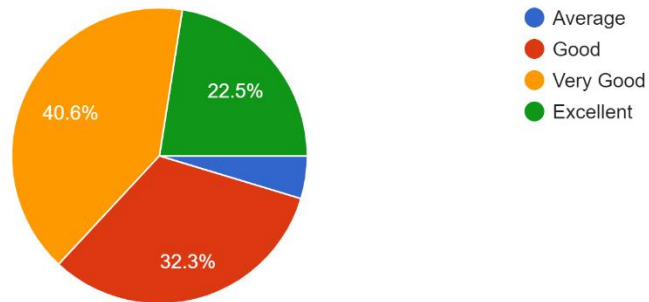

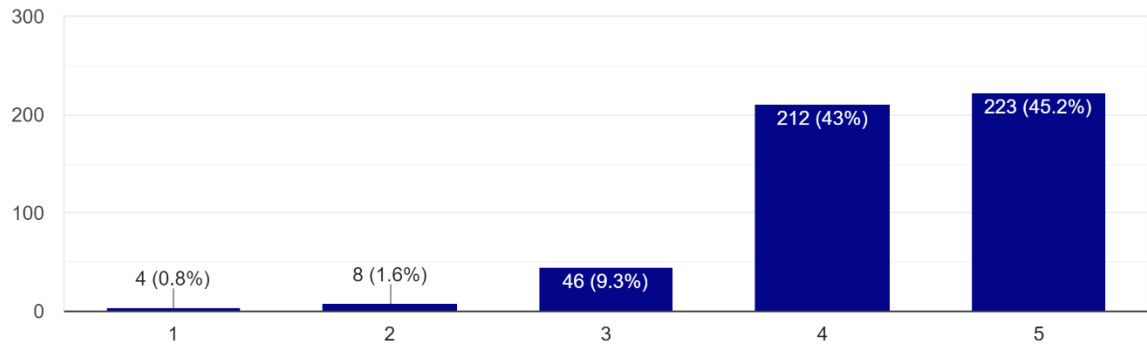

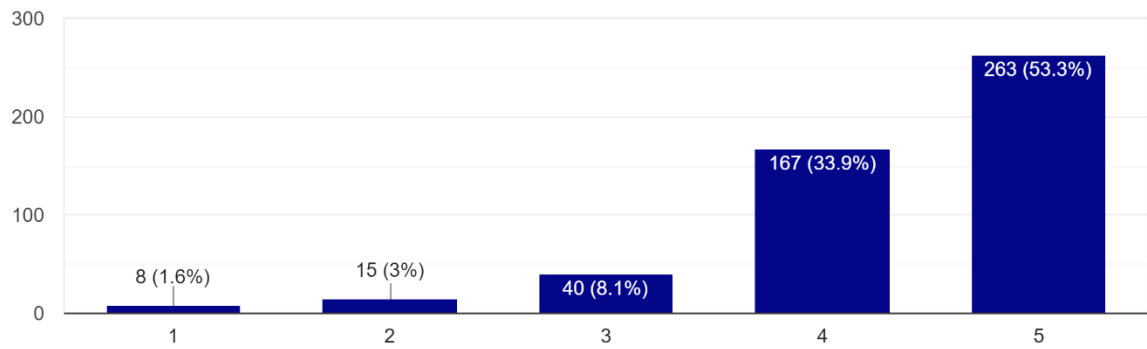

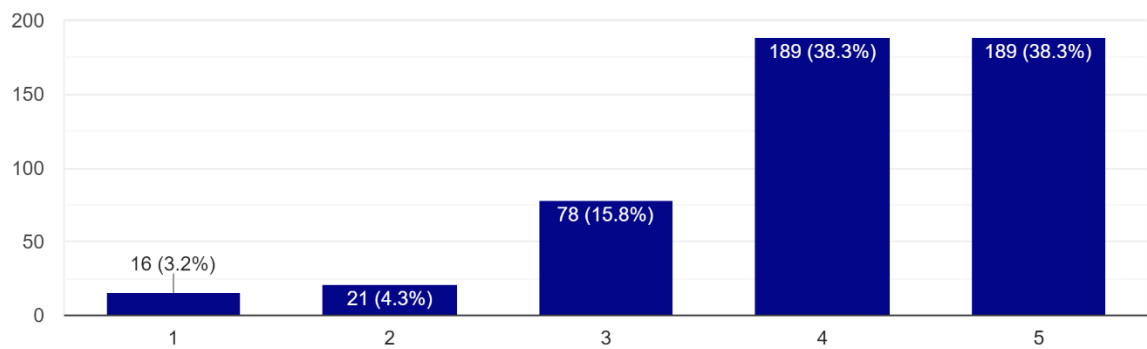

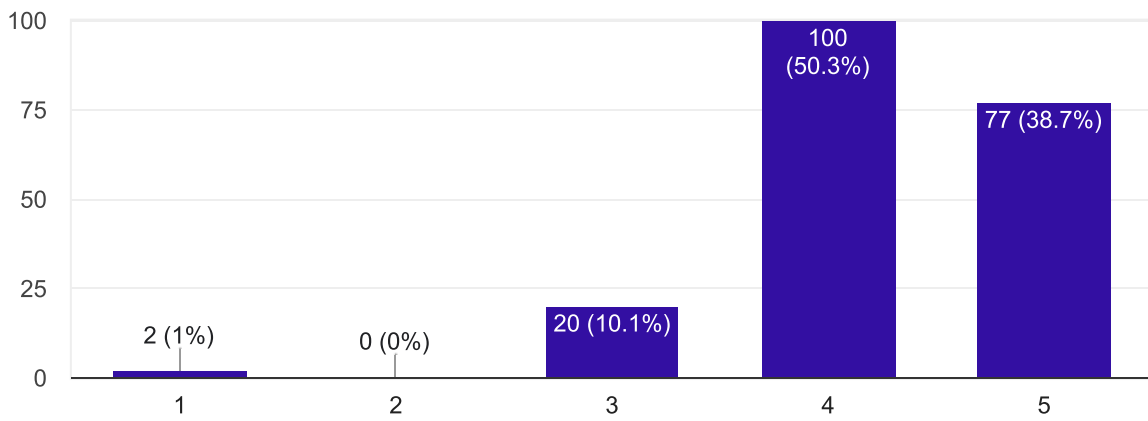

HOW WOULD YOU RATE THE ACADEMIC EXPERIENCE OF YOUR WARD OVER THE LAST 3 YEARS?



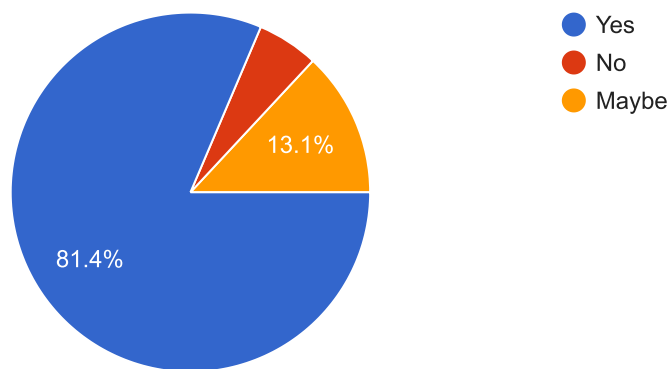

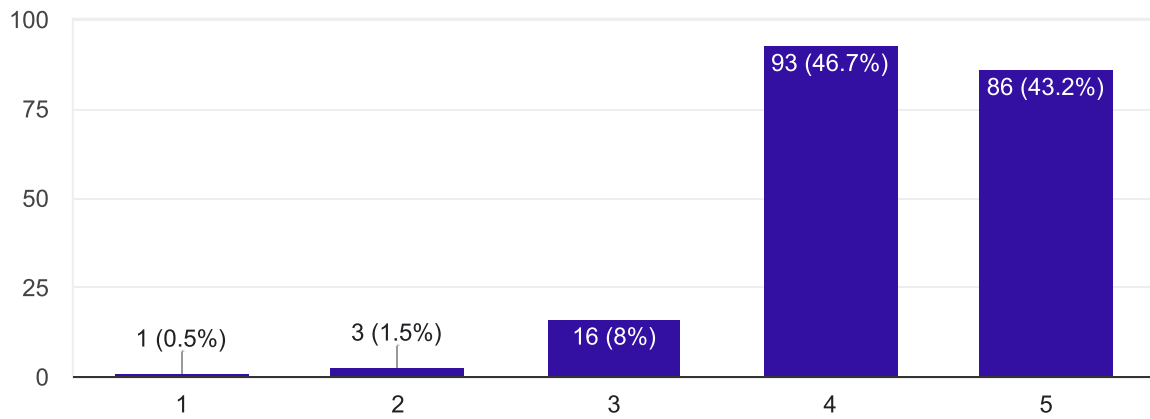




HOW WOULD YOU RATE THE FACULTY OF THE INSTITUTION?
