## Jai Hind College Autonomous, Mumbai. Restarting of College in Offline Mode

Dear Students,

The College will reopen for the Even Semesters (Second Term) on 15.11. 2021. As per the Directives of the University of Mumbai (vide its Circular No. AFF/ICC/ 2021-22/440, dated 16th October 2021) and Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra Order (GR. No. संकीर्ण २०२१ / प्र. क्र. ६ विशि ३,dated 13th October 2021), College shall commence blended teaching in a phased manner.

- The lectures and Practical for the TY Degree Students (Semester VI) will commence in the Offline mode w.e.f 15.11.2021 while the online mode of teaching will also continue for the students who are unable to join in person classes for one reason or another.
- It is also proposed to start the Offline classes along with Online (Blended Teaching) for the Second Year Degree students from the beginning of December, details of which shall be displayed on the website in due course.
- The lectures, practical and the Semester End Exams for the First Year Degree students shall continue to be in the Online mode till further notice.
- This Blended mode of teaching-learning will continue till the University of Mumbai officially declares that physical attendance for all students is mandatory.

Therefore, from 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021, all TY Students are welcome to the Campus to attend Lectures and Practical. Kindly follow the instructions given by your HOD/Department. However, the permission to physically attend lectures/practical in college is conditional and also based on the **Standard Operating Procedure(SOP) for COVID appropriate behaviour in Colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai which are as follows**:

1. Student producing the valid document about being completely vaccinated against Covid19 (GOI given certificate- COVID -19 Final Vaccination Certificate) on the Aarogya Setu app or in hardcopy, on every visit to college, at the college entrance.

- 2. Submission of disclaimer form in hard copy with parental consent therein, submitted to the Departmental Head and obtaining an acknowledgement of the same, and showing it if asked at the college entrance.
- 3. Being found physically fit to attend college (normal body temperature, as detected at point of entry in college) every time the student attends.
- 4. Agreeing to strictly follow all the safety protocols and regulations as mandated by Government of India with regards to prevention of spread of Covid 19 (safety and precautions).
