

7.3.1 Institutional Distinctiveness

At Jai Hind, we believe in nurturing ‘job creators’ rather than ‘job seekers’. The College has worked towards achieving this goal through promotion of entrepreneurship, and nurturing innovative ideas through establishment of an ‘Incubation and Accelerator Centre’ (IAC) as a co-working space for incubated startups to carry out research, innovate and to nurture young businesses. The IAC provides access to regular mentoring sessions by industry experts, a state-of-the-art co-working space as well as technical and financial assistance. More than 50 mentoring sessions have been conducted by renowned industry experts such as ‘Start-Up Valuation - Defining Finance Streams’. The incubator has also been organising the Pre-Incubation Program in collaboration with Wadhvani Foundation generating 50+ practice ventures. This helped the E-cell in gaining recognition from Governmental Organisations like Startup India and the Maharashtra State Innovation Society. The Entrepreneurship Cell and Skill Hub of Jai Hind College has continuously crafted and dispensed the right platforms to foster ‘out-of-the-box ideas’ by holding skill-building sessions, ideation workshops, prototype demonstrations and organising events such as ‘The Global Entrepreneurship Summit’ which provides a platform for young minds to interact with Industry experts, attend masterclasses and experience the Startup Competition.
