Declaration of Results of 2019-20 Even Semesters & Admissions for the Academic Year 2020-21

In view of the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic and national lockdown, the UGC vide its circular dated 27.04.2020, Government of Maharashtra circular dated 08.05.2020 and the University of Mumbai Circular No: Sampavamum/ 2020-21/1, dated 18.05.2020 and Sampavamum/2020-21/4, dated 22.05.2020, have provided guidelines for declaration of Examination results for Even Semesters of UG and PG courses of academic year 2019-2020. (Only for Semester 2 and 4 of UG and Part 1 of PG, as Semester 6 and Part 2 PG decision is still pending). With regard to the above, the process of declaring results and admission to higher classes is given below:

[A] Even Semester results of examinations (FY, SY and PG-I)

As per the guidelines from UGC, GoM and MU, and in order to maintain “social distancing”, safety and health of the students, the Semester End Examination for students of First year and Second year UG and Part 1 students of PG have been cancelled and the results are to be finalized and declared as per the following procedure. Grading of the students will be composite of

- 50% marks on the basis of the pattern of internal evaluation (Continuous Assessment i.e. CA) of even semester and
- The remaining 50% marks will be awarded on the basis of performance in previous semester i.e. Odd semester of academic year 2019-2020.

- There will be no backlog examination in July 2020. These students will be carried forward to next semester and backlog examination will be taken within the next 120 days.
- Students can apply for class improvement in the next semester if required.

[B] Final semester examinations of regular, repeater or backlog students (TY, PG-II)

After receiving further guidelines from UGC, GoM and MU, about conduct of examinations the decision will be taken accordingly.

[C] Eligibility criteria for admissions to the next semester:

- All regular students enrolled in the first-year and the second-year with no backlogs
- All students enrolled (Kept Terms) for the First Year during 2019 – 2020 and those who had been kept back due to backlogs from the previous years are all eligible to take admission to the Second Year (i.e. III Semester) for the Academic Year 2020 - 2021 and
- Similarly, all those students had kept terms for Second year during 2019 - 2020 as well as those who had been kept back due to back logs from the previous years will be eligible to take admissions for the Third year (i.e. Semester V) for the Academic Year 2020 -2021 irrespective of their back logs of any examinations.
- As the results of the Even Semesters of 2019 -2020 are yet to be declared, students do not need to provide details of marks for Semester II in the online

admission forms for Second Year and for Semester IV in the online forms for Third Year.

- while filling the online admission forms for Second Year, the details of marks for the II Semester will not be filled in as they are not available similarly while filling the admission form for Third Year, in the details of marks for the IV Semester will not be filled in as they are not available.
- However, students will be required to clear the backlog during the Academic year as and when the additional examination will be scheduled.
- Admissions to the next semester does not imply that the student has been declared as having passed the previous semester in case the student carries any backlog of courses not hitherto cleared as per the examination ordinances of the institution.
- The admission process would be totally online and the admission forms are available on the College website. The students must follow the instructions carefully and submit a duly completed form according to the timeline/ schedule announced hereunder.
- Students should give their choice of courses wherever applicable carefully and clearly. These courses will be allotted to the students based on merit and availability of seats. Students having backlog/ KT in any course(s) of the previous semester(s) must provide the details in the form.
- For the security of your admission & payment of fees, it is advised not to **share** your personalized Log in ID and Password with anyone.

The schedule for the admission process is as follows:

Filling Up of Admission Forms online

through the College Portal : 04.07.2020 to 07.07.2020

Payment of Fees online : 10.07.2020 to 13.07.2020

- No admission shall be considered complete until the fees are paid through the payment gateway that would open on your screen.

Step by Step guide to complete your admissions for SY/TY Programmes:

Step 1: Go to the Jai Hind College website - <http://jaihindcollege.com> - and go to the Admissions 2020-2021 Link on the Homepage and click on the Links: *SY/TY Degree Admission online Form.*

Step 2: Register/Login with a valid email id and submit your online application form by making a successful payment of form fees. You shall get an application number here.

Step 3: The admissions cell will go through your submitted form and after successful verification shall enable the online payment option for you to pay the requisite college fees. You will get an alert (via mail / sms) informing the activation of college fee payment option.

Step 4: Once you get the alert, you will now have to login to your admissions account with the same email id and password with which you submitted your online application form.

Step 5: After logging in, go to the ‘College Fee’ section in which you will see the total fee amount that needs to be paid online. You are required to pay the same within a stipulated time frame (*i.e.10.07.2020 to 13.7.2020*)

Step 6: Click ‘Pay Now’ and proceed towards payment of college fees. Upon successful payment, you will be able to print the acknowledgment/invoice. Students can make online payment only by Net banking, Debit Card and Credit Card. There will be no bank charges for making online payments of College Fees.

Step 7: Students are required to present copy of the acknowledgement / invoice of fees payment at the college office counter to get a detailed fee receipt once the College re-opens for A.Y. 2020 -2021. Schedule of collection of fees receipts would be sent to Students by email/sms.
