- Admissions to these degree programs will be on the basis of the marks scored at the Entrance Exam (weightage: 60%) and the Standard XII Board Results (Weightage: 40%).
- The Entrance Exam will be scheduled soon after the Class XII Results of Maharashtra State Board which are likely to be declared by the End of July 2021
- The Online Entrance Exam will consist of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) as per the detailed structure specified hereunder. However, there will not be any negative marking.

- Please note that the Schedule of the Entrance Exam and further details of Exams will be announced in due course in tune with the declaration of Class XII Results of Maharashtra State Board.
