

Recapitulating the evolution of ideas of the entrepreneurs from last year, we couldn't help but notice that the smartest entrepreneurs have always recognized that entrepreneurship is moving towards social change, as we embrace the role of modern businesses in society. These are entrepreneurs who are building enterprises with double bottom lines.

Consequently, in order to support such out-of-box ideas and encourage students and startups across the country, students at Jai Hind College (Autonomous), Mumbai took up the initiative of introducing the Global Entrepreneurship Summit. Celebrating the 4th year, Global Entrepreneurship Summit 2020,

with NTT Netmagic as the title sponsor, was held in collaboration with NITI Aayog, NeGD, Digital India, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Skill India, and more. Keeping up with the legacy set forth by the summit in the past years, it wouldn't be incorrect to say that this year was only bigger and better. The 2-day long summit, from the 10th to 11th of January 2020, had a host of exciting things in store which included an array of business competitions, startup competitions, speaker sessions from the who's who of the industry and master classes in areas of Marketing, Risk Management, Food And Technology to name a few.



It hosted an array of challenging competitions, such as Logo Designing, wherein, the participants were assigned a task to design a logo for a new range of products for the artesian water company, Blue Pine, and were given an opportunity to pitch their logos to the Founder of the Blue Pine, Mr. Shrikant Hazare!

Another feather to the cap was the chance given to the winner to have their design used for the new Blue Pine flavored water line. Another among the roster was a life sized business competition, wherein participants competed in a monopoly inspired game, carrying out tasks ranging from market analysis to hiring pitches!

On 11th January, we started Day 2 with the elimination round of startups. The startups had previously been shortlisted from 140+ startups from over the country, from various colleges such as **IIT Delhi, Christ University**, etc.

This was followed by our much awaited keynote session.



The first speaker session for this year's summit unfolded with an insightful session with Mr Ramanan Ramanathan, Mission Director – Atal Innovation Mission, Additional Secretary - Govt. of India. He brought light to how issues like affordable housing, clean water and sanitation need to still be looked upon

closely, which forms a vital part of the Mission. He also elaborated on how innovation is a crucial part of our lives, and how we've been innovating since the moment we were born. According to him, "Team work makes dream work" describing how a good team can go a long way in achieving our goals. He ended his talk with this impressive line of advice, "You are young, you should create, you should innovate, you should make an impact!"

Mr. Ramanan was followed by Anil Joshi, Founder & Managing Partner at Unicorn India Ventures. From the very start, he pulled the entire crowd into a spell with just

three words and a booming voice: **We are Change makers**. The populous today is blessed with ample
resources and opportunities to grow and blossom into
their best selves. He even went onto say, that India is
especially lucky to be plagued with so many problems,

for, he explained, greater the issues, greater the chances to find solutions. Which would mean, more scope for entrepreneurs to give their ideas shape and direction. He ended his speech with warm words and a warmer smile: "Entrepreneurship is a journey, don't be afraid to share your ideas, yourself, with the world".



Mr. Sharad Sanghi, the next speaker, is the CEO and Managing Director of NTT Netmagic. Taking the audience with him down his own 25 years' timeline, he told of the struggles and realities many youths face today. He successfully got into IIT Bombay before getting an MS in Electrical


Engineering from Columbia, yet felt uncertain about future endeavours. It was after working at NSFNET that he felt the innate need to introduce internet services in India, which at the time had only just allowed such permissions. The market had no other competitors, waiting to be filled and flourish, and he took his chance at an opportune time.

Throughout his journey, he learnt several lessons, faced a rollercoasters' worth of ups and downs, and trudged on through the toughest of times. He advised students to not make the same mistakes he did, instead make new ones, and never take both luck and external competitors for granted. "Fail fast, recognise it doesn't work, and move on to the next," he sincerely concluded, at the end.



Next we had Ms. Lina Ashar, Founder of Kangaroo Kids and Billabong High International School. She started the session by a simple yet witty line which said "We are shaped by the experience we experience." Next, she captivated the audience by the inspiring story of her life and how it led to the initialization of Billabong School and Kangaroo Kids.

She also elaborated on how the biggest difference between **Winners** and **Losers** is not the efficiency of one over inefficiency of other but "The stories we tell ourselves" when we win or lose. Ending the session on a good note, Ms. Lina concluded saying "Every thought affects the brain; the thoughts in the brain shape our beliefs thereby shaping our reality."



Ms Lina Ashar was followed by Vikram Bhatt, Founder & Director, Enrich, who chose to start the session by sharing his journey onto becoming the founder of one of the leading chain of unisex salons in India. Sharing his journey, he described Enrich as a happy accident he witnessed. Taking the example of his own life, he assured the audience on

how decision making is a conventional phrase in the entrepreneurial process and that one always ends up opting for something which is totally different than one had in mind. Lastly, he ended the session with an impactful sentence which said "Not everyone or everything can be timed perfectly"



Ending the speaker session was an insightful session with Mr. Anuj Puri, Chairman and Founder, ANAROCK Consultants. Starting the session on a light note, he described how he being a consultant is the one who is considered as 1) uninvited 2) telling people things they probably already know 3) not knowing what he's doing. Coming back to nitty-gritties of entrepreneurship he also shared the principles one should abide by being an entrepreneur which included if you really want something,

get it! Furthermore, he added how it's important to always keep a check on one's facts before stepping into a business. Next he also threw light over how while hiring, one should always hire people who are more talented than you and adding that there's no substitute to hard work. Moreover, he also elaborated on how one should always keep a check on gender diversity in one's organization which plays a vital role in success of the organization.

Following the speaker session was a networking lunch, where speakers, mentors, startups & students were given an opportunity to interact & network.
