





At age 26, when I decided to transition into coaching, the world laughed at a 26 year old "inexperienced coach". At 26 I was an experienced player but an inexperienced coach...strange!

But I carried on. And even today, at 33, I still am the youngest coach by a long margin, but no one calls me inexperienced


